Operated by the Carmelite Sisters of the Most Sacred Heart of Los Angeles, Santa Teresita continues the spirit and legacy of our Venerable Mother Luisita, who first founded our campus in 1930 as a tuberculosis sanatorium for the care of young women. Over the decades, our campus has faithfully grown to meet the changing needs of those we serve, as an acute-care hospital from 1955-2004, evolving into a Neighborhood of Care today, specializing in assisted living for seniors 65+.

Our mission is rooted in the ethical principles of the Catholic Church and a deep respect for the dignity of life at every stage. Guided by our core values of being **Joyful, Authentic, Totally Given**, and having a **Family Spirit**, our sisters and dedicated co-workers are committed to caring for the physical, spiritual, and relational needs of each resident. We strive to create a warm, home-like environment where every individual is known, loved, and cherished - empowering them to live with purpose, vibrancy, and fulfillment throughout their golden years.

Our Assisted Living Cottages

Cristo Rey and Good Shepherd Cottages offer a warm, home-like setting designed for comfort and charm. Each Craftsman-style cottage is a two-story building, including 22 private, apartment-style rooms, accommodating between 22 and 28 residents. Prospective residents may choose from five different floor plans: Small Studio, Studio, Studio Deluxe, One-Bedroom Suite, and Two-Bedroom Suite, allowing flexibility to select the unit and layout that best suits their needs and preferences.
